2024 Pennsylvania High School Pickleball Championships

Official Rules

Player Eligibility: Pennsylvania High School student (public, private, cyber, home school etc.)

Brackets: Male and Female doubles; players must come from the same school or feeder program; Photo ID will be used for verification

Suggested Skill Level is Intermediate and above

Example Intermediate Pickleball skills include:

- 1. Able to keep score
- 2. Able to consistently serve deep in the box
- 3. Solid understanding of the non-volley "kitchen" zone
- 4. Able to return serve and move in towards the net
- 5. Understand the basics of the dink shot
- 6. Experience communicating with teammate during doubles play
- 7. Good Sportsmanship

Bracket Timing: Male (8am – 1pm) Female (1:30pm – 6:30pm)

Championships Format (Round Robin then Single Elimination):

Opening Matches (Round Robin)

All teams will be randomly assigned to play two games. Games will be played to 11 points.

Single Elimination

- 1. At the conclusion of the Round Robin, teams will be seeded based on record and point differential. For example, if two teams each finish 2-0 during Round Robin, the team with a larger point differential during Round Robin would be the higher seed. If teams are still tied, a single coin toss will determine the higher seed.
- 2. Games will be played first to 11 points, win by one.
- 3. Each team will be allowed one, one-minute timeout.
- 4. Play challenges will be made to the assigned Court Judge. The Tournament Head Judge has final call on all aspects of play.

Finals and Consolation Round

- 1. The Finals will consist of a best of three games format, played to 11, win by two.
- 2. Consolation Round (those losing the semi-finals) will play one game first to 11, win by one, to determine 3rd and 4th places.

General Rules of Play

- 1. The Championships will follow USA Pickleball rules (2024 Edition, Revision 1)
- 2. Spectators, including coaches and parents, must remain outside the fence during the Championships. Spectators will be allowed onto the court area for the Finals Round.
- 3. Restrooms, seating areas and refreshments will be available.

Awards

 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place finishers will receive recognition.
