Foam Cannon Rules & FAQs

- We hope you enjoy your foam cannon experience! While this will be fun, please make you understand set up and safety considerations before the big event!
- Rental Period
 - Foam cannon rentals are from Thursday/Friday to Monday and can be picked up at the Township Bldg between 9a-4p.
- Considerations:
 - Only those eighteen years and older can handle the foam cannon equipment
 - Set up instructions:
 - 1) Identify space for the foam cannon, recommended at least 10' perimeter in all directions. The foam will shoot approximately 10-15' out from the cannon, so the "play zone" will need to be larger
 - 2) Wide base tri-pod set up on flat ground, three sand bags strapped to legs
 - 3) Foam Cannon placed on top of tri-pod
 - 4) Cords inserted into cannon and safety strapped to tri-pod
 - 5) Four cones set up at least 5' from tri-pod with safety rods attached
 - 6) Blue box plugged into a GFCI outlet (do not turn on yet)
 - 7) Mix two packets into container with water for approx.. 5 minutes, per directions. Be careful when putting powder in, it can blow around.
 - 8) Drop water pump into container
 - 9) Turn on cannon fan, let run for ten seconds before moving onto next step
 - 10) Plug in water pump; foam should start shooting out immediately
 - Tear Down instructions:
 - 1) Unplug water pump; let fan run for 10 seconds before moving onto next step
 - 2) Turn off cannon fan
 - 3) Unplug blue box and various cord connections
 - 4) Lightly rinse the foam cannon and accessories with regular water if necessary
 - 5) Let the foam cannon dry (approximately 10 minutes), then remove from tri-pod and place inside container
 - 6) Continue placing cords on the container and close up the tri-pod

FAQs

- Two foam packets will last for approximately 15 minutes of continuous use and will make mountains of foam. We recommend an Operator turning it on/off every five minutes or so, letting the kids play in the foam. This will keep the foam at manageable levels and extend the play time for the kids to more than one hour.
- If you purchase more foam from a third party vendor, it can only be the Party
 Machines powder variety. The foam cannon is specifically designed to be used only
 with this foam powder.
- O The foam is 100% organic, hypoallergenic, won't stain clothes and was created by a Board-certified Dermatologist. It won't cause skin irritation or rash with general use. We recommend kids wear the included goggles, especially if they are going to "sit" in the foam and cover their faces for the duration. In that scenario, the foam may cause similar eye irritation to swimming in a chlorinated pool for an extended period of time. If any eye or skin irritation does occur, simply wash with cool water until the irritation goes away. We do not recommend putting the foam on your face if you wear contacts.
